In January of 1950, local men and women set out with unbeatable resolution to solve the great hospital crisis and raise \$644,860.00 in order to build the new St. John's Hospital. Unfortunately \$25,000 worth of pledges did not come through for the construction project. In 1952, Sr. Constance approached Dr. W. C. Huff about the deficit problem and he gathered a core group of dedicated men to solve the problem. This small band of Ventura County doctors and businessmen dubbed themselves the "Humanitarians."
