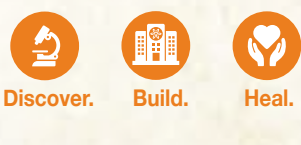

Join us as we honor the recipients of the Adventure 2019 Catherine McAuley Lifetime Achievement Award

Adventure 2019 – An Evening in Venice, will bring together over 400 supporters of St. John's Hospitals, to honor Dr. Robert Improta and Jerry Zins for their outstanding volunteer service in the community.



ROBERT S. IMPROTA, MD

Robert Improta, MD arrived in Camarillo in 1977. He was the only Plastic and Reconstructive Surgeon in Camarillo at that time covering Santa Paula Hospital, Community Memorial, County General, Ojai, St. John's in Oxnard, and Pleasant Valley, alone, for almost 10 years. During this time, Dr. Improta performed reconstructive surgeries that included trauma, cancer and birth deformities.

In 1988 Dr. Improta developed and opened the first accredited surgical center in Ventura County. He was one of the very first medical doctors trained in microvascular surgery in Southern California. His extensive experience in training came from his time at New York Hospital's - Cornell Medical Center, where microvascular surgery was developed.

Dr. Improta participated with International Relief Teams in Albania where they treated 80,000 war evacuees from Kosovo. When the war ended, he and his nurse/wife Patricia were the first two people to drive over the border with Australian Armed Forces to open a hospital in Kosovo in 1999 to help patients. His work for the people didn't stop

there, he then traveled to Ecuador to do cleft lip and cleft palate surgeries and ventured on to Mexico to perform general reconstructive surgeries.

Dr. Improta's work came full circle when he returned to Camarillo, where he had the opportunity to train Family Practice Residents at the County Hospital. Newer aspects of the specialty were added to his practice, such as breast reconstruction following mastectomy. Dr. Improta was also able to perform a great number of surgeries for local residents in Ventura County who had no insurance, he explained "it was the right thing to do." You will still find Dr. Improta performing exceptional plastic surgery work in his Camarillo practice. Pacifica Institute of Cosmetic & Reconstructive Surgery, the medical practice he established with his wife Patricia in 1977 and sold to partner, Dr. Daniel Kolder, in 2013. Dr. Improta is proud to support an annual scholarship, The Patricia Improta Memorial Scholarship, which assists students interested in a career in nursing.

A personal note from Dr. Improta: I will always be grateful for the opportunity to live and practice medicine in this very outstanding climate and community with as nice a population as I could have ever hoped for. To all of the people who have so deeply touched me, my wife Pat, and our family's lives, I thank you so very deeply from the bottom of my heart.

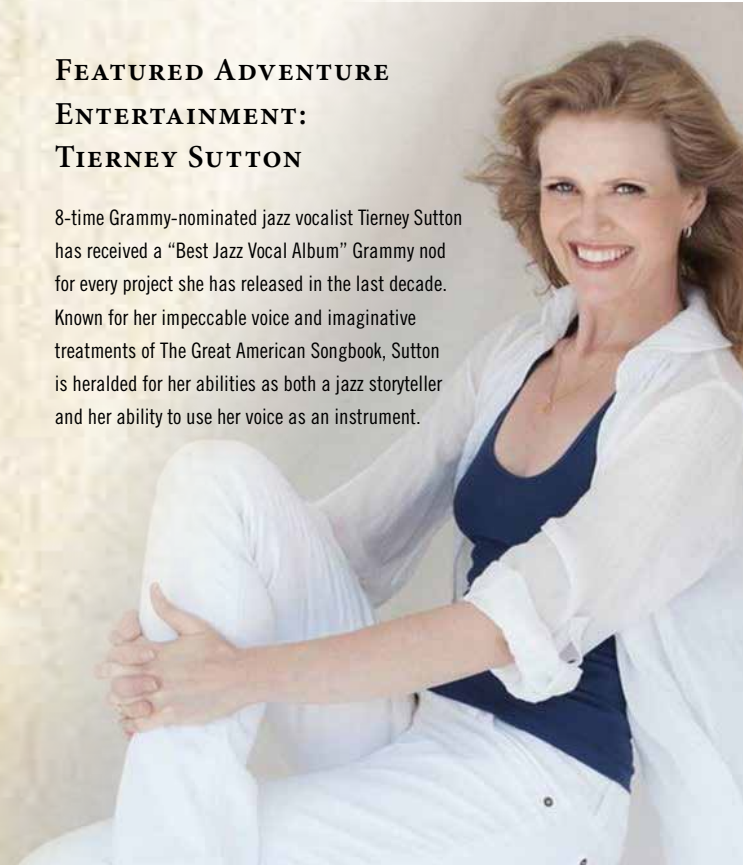
